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A Message from the founder of Bronzeville Push for Peace



In times of fear and discord, it is easy to feel overwhelmed—scattered by uncertainty, silenced by anxiety, and separated by suspicion. **Fear feeds division. Discord turns neighbor against neighbor.** In such moments, unity can seem like a distant ideal, fragile and elusive. But it is precisely then that unity becomes most powerful—because it is chosen, not assumed. **True unity is not the absence of conflict or difference. It is the commitment to stand together in spite of them.** When people choose to see each other not as enemies but as fellow travelers through crisis, something profound begins to happen: fear begins to lose its grip. Unity gives strength to the weary. It gives clarity in the midst of confusion. It does not erase hardship, but it gives hardship meaning. In the presence of unity, discord can be confronted—not with hatred, but with shared humanity. It reminds us that our struggles are not isolated, and that we are not alone. The power of unity lies not in uniformity, but in the collective will to move forward together. It is found in the quiet acts of kindness that bind us. In the difficult conversations that build bridges. In the refusal to let fear dictate our values or our future.
